BUCK SHOTS

- The Milwaukee Bucks continue their five-game homestand on Tuesday with a matchup against the Boston Celtics. With four games left in the regular season, the Bucks remain in second place in the Eastern Conference standings with a record of 47-31 and sit a game up on both the Magic and Cavaliers. Tonight's game is the penultimate home game of the season for Milwaukee, which ends the homestand tomorrow against Orlando.
- The Bucks clinched a playoff spot on Sunday, marking their eighth consecutive playoff berth. Milwaukee's eight straight years making the postseason trails only Boston (10) for the longest active playoff streak in the NBA. In franchise history, this is the second-longest playoff streak, trailing only the 12 consecutive years the team made the playoffs from 1980-91.
- Giannis Antetokounmpo has been filling the stat sheet of late, hauling in 15+ rebounds in five of his last seven games and dishing out eight or more assists in each of his last four games. Antetokounmpo led the Bucks with 28 points, 15 rebounds and eight assists against New York on Sunday and enters tonight's game 2nd in the NBA in scoring (30.7 ppg), T-5th in rebounding (11.6 rpg), 14th in assists (career-high 6.5 apg) and 7th in FG% (career-high 61.1%). With four games remaining, Antetokounmpo remains on pace to become the first player in NBA history to average 30+ points on 60% shooting in a season.
- On the homestand so far, Bobby Portis Jr. is averaging 20.7 points and 7.3 rebounds per game while shooting 53.1% from the field and 53.3% from three. He went 10-for-15 overall, including 4-for-6 from three, and scored 24 points on Sunday against the Knicks, which was his 13th game of the season scoring 20+ points. That surpasses the 12 20-point games he had last season and now trails only the 15 such games he had in 2021-22 for the most in a season in his career.
- Tracking Malik Beasley and Damian Lillard's pursuit of the franchise record for 3-point makes in a season, Beasley (218) is now 12 threes away from passing Ray Allen's mark of 229 threes in 2001-02 for the most in franchise history, while Lillard (215) is 15 away.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks vs. Knicks – Sunday, April 7 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, WI

L, 109-122 – Milwaukee struggled in the second half of Sunday's game, falling 109-122 to New York at Fiserv Forum. Giannis Antetokounmpo and Damian Lillard scored 18 and 14 points, respectively, in the first half to propel the Bucks to a 61-50 halftime lead, shooting 52.6% from the field and holding the Knicks to just 37.3% shooting through two quarters. New York flipped the script coming out of the half as it outscored Milwaukee 24-39 in the third quarter. Bobby Portis Jr. was a bright spot for the Bucks in the frame, scoring 10 points to keep it an 85-89 game heading into the fourth quarter. Antetokounmpo opened the scoring in the final frame to cut it to an 87-89 game, but the Knicks capitalized on their third-quarter momentum to go ahead by double digits. Down 89-102 with 8:01 remaining, the Bucks went on a 9-2 run to make it a 98-104 deficit, but the Knicks pulled away again and kept the Bucks from attempting a comeback. Antetokounmpo neared a triple-double with 28 points, 15 rebounds and eight assists, while Portis Jr. scored 24 points off the bench. Lillard finished with 23 points and six assists, and Brook Lopez chipped in 13 points of his own. The Knicks were led by Jalen Brunson with 43 points.

Bucks vs. Raptors – Friday, April 5 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, WI

L, 111-117 – The Bucks continued their five-game homestand on Friday, falling 111-117 to the Raptors at Fiserv Forum. Milwaukee led 27-21 at the end of the first quarter, but Toronto shot 60.9% from the field in the second to take a 54-58 halftime lead. Damian Lillard scored 13 of the Bucks' 31 third-quarter points as they began to attempt a comeback, cutting it to an 85-90 game through three quarters. Trying to generate momentum, the Bucks opened the final frame on a 13-7 run to take a 98-97 lead, their first since the second quarter. The Raptors answered to retake the lead, but Khris Middleton tied the game at 100 with a fadeaway shot. After a Toronto free throw to make it a 100-101 game, Lillard scored again to put Milwaukee on top 102-101. The Raptors retook the lead with a three, but Lillard made two free throws to tie it at 104 with 4:21 remaining. Toronto pulled away again, taking a 104-107 lead, and Lillard made two more free throws to cut it to a one-point deficit. The Bucks kept it close but couldn't complete the comeback at the end. Lillard, who was returning to the lineup after missing three games, finished with 36 points and six assists, while Middleton scored 21 points for his third straight game with 20+ points. Bobby Portis Jr. had 19 points and 10 rebounds off the bench for his 15th double-double of the season. The Raptors were led by Gary Trent Jr. with 31 points.

L, 101-111 – Playing in the first game of their five-game homestand, the Bucks fell 101-111 to the Grizzlies at Fiserv Forum on Wednesday. Milwaukee and Memphis battled closely for the first three quarters, with neither team leading by more than 10 points, and the Bucks trailed 78-79 entering the final frame. The Bucks opened the fourth on a 9-6 run, with a Malik Beasley three giving them an 87-85 lead. After the Grizzlies answered to tie it at 87, Bobby Portis Jr. made a layup to keep the Bucks on top. Memphis tied it again at 89, and despite a free throw from Giannis Antetokounmpo they took a 90-91 lead with 5:59 remaining in the quarter. The Bucks never led from that point as the Grizzlies pulled away to complete the win. Brook Lopez led the Bucks with 25 points and 10 rebounds, marking his fifth double-double of the season. Antetokounmpo neared a triple-double with 21 points, seven rebounds and eight assists, while Portis Jr. chipped in 19 points and seven rebounds off the bench. The Grizzlies were led by Jaren Jackson Jr. with 35 points.

Down as many as 21 points late in the third quarter, the Bucks climbed all the way back in the fourth quarter and trailed by just three after a Bobby Portis Jr. three with 2:56 to play. After the Celtics went back up by seven, a Damian Lillard three and a Portis Jr. bucket got the Bucks to within two, 116-114, with 32.6 seconds remaining. A couple of Boston free throws and Milwaukee misses on the ensuing possessions, however, ultimately gave the Celtics a three-point victory. Lillard led the Bucks with 32 points while Portis Jr. finished with 24 points, 14 of which came in the fourth quarter during Milwaukee's comeback, to go along with 15 rebounds. Khris Middleton also chipped in 22 points for the Bucks. The Celtics were led by Jayson Tatum who scored 31 points. Boston started this one strong, taking a 69-56 lead at halftime, before pushing its lead to 20+ points in the third quarter. The Bucks ended up outscoring the Celtics 36-21 in the fourth quarter.

Milwaukee started hot in the first quarter, jumping to a 12-2 lead just two and a half minutes in, but Orlando opened an 18-5 run to take the lead. Despite 13 first-quarter points from Giannis Antetokounmpo, Orlando outscored Milwaukee 28-31 in the first. The Bucks turned up the defensive energy in the second quarter to hold the Magic without a three in the frame while Antetokounmpo scored another 10 points to lead the Bucks to a 59-56 halftime lead. Milwaukee came out strong in the third quarter, opening on a 21-9 run to take an 80-65 lead, its largest of the game, with 6:14 left in the third. The Bucks never trailed from that point, withstanding a comeback effort from the Magic that cut it to a 93-91 game with 9:02 remaining in the fourth. Orlando kept it a close game within the final two minutes, but Milwaukee made 10 free throws in the final 56.5 seconds to seal the win. Antetokounmpo finished with a team-high 37 points and 10 rebounds, while Damian Lillard dished out eight assists and chipped in 24 points of his own. Orlando was led by Franz Wagner with 29 points.

DAME TIME IN INDY: It was Dame Time in Indianapolis during NBA All-Star Weekend as Bucks guard Damian Lillard stole the show by winning the 3-point contest on Saturday before being named the MVP of the 73rd NBA All-Star Game on Sunday. In doing so, he joined Michael Jordan as the only players in NBA history to win a Saturday night event and be named MVP of the All-Star Game in the same year. Lillard won his second consecutive 3-point contest by defeating Karl-Anthony Towns and Trae Young in the final round before scoring a team-high 39 points, while knocking down a game-high 11 threes, in the All-Star Game on Sunday to win MVP.



BUCKS REPRESENT AT ALL-STAR WEEKEND: In addition to Lillard, the Bucks were well represented during NBA All-Star Weekend. Giannis Antetokounmpo, who was the league's leading vote getter and team captain for the Eastern Conference All-Stars, made his eighth consecutive All-Star Game start, while the Bucks coaching staff earned the right to coach the East All-Stars. Led by head coach Doc Rivers, it was the fourth time that Milwaukee has had its coaching staff coach the All-Star Game. Bucks guard Malik Beasley also made his NBA All-Star Weekend debut, participating in the 3-point contest alongside Lillard.

NOTEABLE GAMES & PERFORMANCES: The Bucks have had some notable team and player performances so far this season. See below for some of Milwaukee's noteworthy games from the 2023-24 season.

- Oct. 26 vs. PHI:
 - In the 2023-24 season opener, Damian Lillard scores 39 points, including 14 in the fourth quarter, to give the Bucks a season-opening 118-117 win over the 76ers. Lillard's 39 points were the most ever by a player making his Bucks debut and the fourth-most in NBA history by a player in his debut with a team.
- Nov. 3 vs. NYK:
 - In the franchise's first In-Season Tournament game, Brook Lopez blocked a career-high-tying 9 shots, helping the Bucks win their first In-Season Tournament game.
- Nov. 9 at IND:
 - Giannis Antetokounmpo scores 54 points, marking the most points scored by a Buck in a road game in franchise history.

- Dec. 6 vs. NYK:
 - The Bucks pour in a season-high 146 points to defeat the Knicks, 146-122, in the Quarterfinals of the In-Season Tournament at Fiserv Forum to advance to the Semifinals of the IST in Las Vegas.
- Dec. 13 vs. IND:
 - Giannis Antetokounmpo scores a franchise record and career-high 64 points, going 20-for-28 from the field (.714) and 24-for-32 from the free-throw line. By doing so, he became only the fifth player in NBA history to score 60+ points on 70% shooting.
- Jan. 14 vs. SAC:
 - Damian Lillard hits a game-winning three at the buzzer to give the Bucks a 143-142 overtime win over the Kings. With the Bucks down two, Lillard received the inbounds pass, ran the length of the court and hoisted a 32-foot jumper that was nothing but net and sent Fiserv Forum into a frenzy.
- Feb. 3 at DAL
 - Down 25 points at one point, the Bucks come back to beat the Mavericks in Dallas, 129-117. Coupled with their 26-point comeback against the Trail Blazers on Nov. 26, the Bucks now own the two largest comeback wins in the NBA this season. Two high-scoring efficient nights from Antetokounmpo, who had 48 points on 71.4% shooting (20-28 FG) and Lillard, who had 30 points on 90.9% shooting (10-11 FG, 5-5 3FG), powered Milwaukee to the victory.

HEAD COACH DOC RIVERS

Doc Rivers, an NBA Champion head coach and one of the greatest coaches of all-time, takes over as the 18th head coach in franchise history, bringing 24 seasons of head coaching experience to the Bucks. Hired by the team on Jan. 26, Rivers steps in with 36 games remaining in the regular season and with Milwaukee once again near the top of the Eastern Conference standings and its sights set on another deep playoff run.

As head coach of the Orlando Magic (1999-03), Boston Celtics (2004-13), Los Angeles Clippers (2013-20) and Philadelphia 76ers (2020-23), Rivers racked up 1,097 wins, good for ninth-most in NBA history, and owned an overall record of 1,097-763 (.590). He's led his teams to the playoffs in 19 of his 24 seasons as a head coach, with two trips to the NBA Finals and an NBA Championship with the Celtics in 2008. His 111 playoff wins are the fourth-most in league history.

The 1999-00 NBA Coach of the Year, Rivers was named one of the 15 Greatest Coaches in NBA history in 2022 by a panel of 43 current and former NBA head coaches in collaboration with the National Basketball Coaches Association. Overall, his combined 1,208 regular season and playoff wins as a head coach are the eighth-most in NBA history.

Most recently, Rivers served as head coach of the 76ers for three seasons from 2020-23 where he amassed a 154-82 (.653) regular season record and made the postseason all three years. Including his three trips to the playoffs with the 76ers, Rivers has advanced to the playoffs in 15 of his last 16 seasons as a head coach going back to 2008.

A native of Chicago and product of Proviso East High School in Maywood, Illinois, Rivers played and graduated from Marquette University, and his number 31 jersey hangs in the rafters of Fiserv Forum. After being selected in the Second Round of the 1983 NBA Draft, Rivers went on to play 13 seasons in the NBA between 1983-96 with the Hawks, Clippers, Knicks and Spurs. He appeared in 864 games in his career, including in 81 playoff games, and was an NBA All-Star in 1988.
