BUCK SHOTS

- Coming off a 2-0 homestand, the Milwaukee Bucks hit the road for one game to take on the top-seeded team in the East, the Boston Celtics, on Wednesday. The Bucks knocked off the Suns at Fiserv Forum, 140-129, in their most recent game on Sunday to improve to 44-24 overall this season and remain in second place in the East. Tonight's game is the start of a back-to-back for Milwaukee, which hosts Brooklyn on Thursday.
- Sunday's game was the league-high ninth time this season the Bucks have put up 140 points. Only the Denver Nuggets in 1981-82 (10) have tallied more 140-point games in a season in NBA history. Averaging a franchise-high 120.7 ppg this season, the Bucks own a 9-0 record this season when scoring 140+ points, an 18-1 record when scoring 130+ points and a 31-4 mark when scoring 120+ points.
- In Sunday's game against the Suns, Damian Lillard became the first player in franchise history to score 30+ points and record 15+ assists in a game as he scored 31 points (10-19 FG, 4-8 3FG, 7-7 FT) and dished out a career-high-tying 16 assists. The Bucks are now 16-1 this season when Lillard scores 30+ points, 27-4 when he scores 25+ points, 9-2 when he tallies 10+ assists and a perfect 22-0 when he shoots 50% from the field.
- Bobby Portis Jr. added a season-high-tying 31 points and 10 rebounds off the bench in Sunday's win over the Suns, marking the eighth 30-point game and the third 30/10 game in his career. Portis Jr., who is tied for second in the NBA with 882 points off the bench this season, has now reached double figures in scoring in 16 of his last 17 games and is averaging 16.1 points on 52.5% shooting from the field with a 44.2% mark from distance during those 17 games.
- The Bucks knocked down a season-high 24 threes in their win over Phoenix on Sunday, including 18 in the first half, which is tied for the most threes made in a half in NBA history. Five of those threes came from Malik Beasley and four came from Lillard, who are now both tied for third for the most made threes in a season in franchise history with 191. Only Ray Allen in 2001-02 (229) and 2000-01 (202) has made more 3s in a season in Bucks history.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks vs. Suns – Sunday, March 17 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, WI

W, 140-129 – Damian Lillard and Bobby Portis Jr. combined for 62 points as the Bucks defeated the Suns 140-129 in a Sunday matinee at Fiserv Forum. Phoenix led for the majority of the first quarter, and Milwaukee trailed 23-24 with 4:24 remaining in the frame. Portis Jr. entered the game and gave the Bucks a 25-24 lead before scoring 12 points in just four minutes of play. The Bucks continued rolling, scoring a season-high 43 points in the second quarter, and finished the first half with a season-high 82 points. Milwaukee's 22-point halftime lead was also due to its 18 first-half threes, which were tied for the most 3FGM in a half in NBA history. The Suns attempted a second-half comeback and cut it to a 128-120 game with just 5:09 remaining in the fourth quarter. Jae Crowder and Lillard each made threes to put the Bucks back up 134-120, and they led by double digits for the remainder of the game. Lillard and Portis Jr. each scored 31 points and had a double-double, with Lillard dishing out a career-high-tying 16 assists and Portis Jr. hauling in 10 rebounds. Khris Middleton had 22 points and seven assists in his return to the lineup, while Crowder (18), Malik Beasley (17) and Brook Lopez (10) all also scored in double figures for the Bucks. The Suns were led by Bradley Beal with 28 points.

Bucks vs. 76ers – Thursday, March 14 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, WI

W, 114-105 – The Bucks returned to Fiserv Forum with a 114-105 comeback victory over the 76ers on Thursday. After trailing by as many as 12 points earlier in the game, Milwaukee entered the fourth quarter facing just an 80-83 deficit. Philadelphia opened the scoring in the final frame, but Damian Lillard made a floating shot that tipped off an 11-2 run to give the Bucks a 91-87 lead. The 76ers made a three to pull the Bucks' lead back to one point, but AJ Green made a three that sent the Bucks back up 94-90 with 6:50 remaining. The Bucks never trailed from that point as they outscored the 76ers 34-22 in the final frame, shooting 68.8% from the field. Giannis Antetokounmpo scored 13 points in the fourth quarter alone, while Green and Bobby Portis Jr. combined for 12 points in the final frame to shift the game in the Bucks' favor. Antetokounmpo finished with a team-high 32 points and 11 rebounds, while Lillard scored 17 points and dished out nine assists. Green scored 14 points in a career-high 28 minutes, and Brook Lopez made five threes and scored 19 points. The 76ers were led by Tyrese Maxey with 30 points.

Bucks at Kings – Tuesday, March 12 – Golden 1 Center – Sacramento, CA

L, 94-129 – In the final game of their four-game West Coast road trip, the Bucks fell 94-129 to the Kings at Golden 1 Center on Tuesday. Sacramento started hot from three, shooting 72.7% from behind the arc in the first quarter. Milwaukee trailed 30-38 at the of the first and cut it to a 36-42 game just two minutes into the second quarter. Giannis Antetokounmpo scored 14 points in the second, but the Kings shot 64% from the field in the frame and owned a 56-75 lead at the half. The Bucks scored 22 points in the third quarter while holding the Kings to just 20 points on 30.4% shooting, but the first-half deficit proved to be too large for Milwaukee to overcome. Antetokounmpo finished with a game-high 30 points and 13 rebounds, while Damian Lillard scored 10 points and dished out six assists. Malik Beasley made three threes and scored 11 points, while Bobby Portis Jr. also scored 11 points and extended his streak of games with 10+ points to 15 games, the third-longest such streak of his career. The Kings were led by De'Aaron Fox with 29 points.

Bucks vs. Celtics – Thursday, Jan. 11 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, WI

W, 135-102 – In a battle of the top two teams in the East, it was a dominating performance by the Bucks at Fiserv Forum on Thursday as they had their largest win of the season in a wire-to-wire 135-102 win over the Celtics. Milwaukee came out of the gates strong, opening up an 11-2 lead in the first quarter before a 25-0 run from the 1:54 mark of the first quarter to the 7:38 mark of the second quarter put them up 33 at 56-23. The Bucks never looked back from there, leading by 37, 75-38, at halftime, which marked the fourth-largest halftime lead in franchise history. Down 37, the Celtics held their starters out of the second half as the Bucks pushed their lead to as many as 43 points in the third quarter before going on to win by 33. Bobby Portis Jr. led the Bucks with 28 points and a season-high-tying 12 rebounds while Giannis Antetokounmpo added 24 points, 10 rebounds and six assists and Damian Lillard chipped in 21 points. The Celtics were led by Payton Pritchard who scored 21 points.

W, 144-122 – A hot shooting and high-scoring night propelled the Bucks to a 144-122 win over the Nets at Barclays Center on Wednesday night. Milwaukee shot 58.4% overall and knocked down 23 of its 51 3-point attempts, while dishing out a season-high 41 assists, en route to its fifth 140-point game and fourth-largest win of the season. Giannis Antetokounmpo neared a triple-double in the win, scoring 32 points (on 83.3% shooting) with 10 rebounds and eight assists, while Khris Middleton scored a season-high 27 points and dished out a season-high 10 assists. Cameron Payne also came off the bench and matched his season-high of 18 points for the Bucks, who improved to 2-1 on their road trip. It was a close game through the first three quarters of play with the Bucks taking a 66-59 lead at halftime before the Nets pulled ahead by one, 79-78, with 5:21 remaining in the third quarter. Milwaukee regained the lead on its next possession, however, and didn't relinquish it the rest of the game, going on to outscore Brooklyn 44-30 in the fourth quarter to win by 22. The Bucks shot 60% as a team in the final quarter of play, and made seven threes, while holding the Nets to just 32% shooting. The Nets were led by Jalen Wilson who scored 21 points with 10 rebounds.

DAME TIME IN INDY: It was Dame Time in Indianapolis during NBA All-Star Weekend as Bucks guard Damian Lillard stole the show by winning the 3-point contest on Saturday before being named the MVP of the 73rd NBA All-Star Game on Sunday. In doing so, he joined Michael Jordan as the only players in NBA history to win a Saturday night event and be named MVP of the All-Star Game in the same year. Lillard won his second consecutive 3-point contest by defeating Karl-Anthony Towns and Trae Young in the final round before scoring a team-high 39 points, while knocking down a game-high 11 threes, in the All-Star Game on Sunday to win MVP.



BUCKS REPRESENT AT ALL-STAR WEEKEND: In addition to Lillard, the Bucks were well represented during NBA All-Star Weekend. Giannis Antetokounmpo, who was the league's leading vote getter and team captain for the Eastern Conference All-Stars, made his eighth consecutive All-Star Game start, while the Bucks coaching staff earned the right to coach the East All-Stars. Led by head coach Doc Rivers, it was the fourth time that Milwaukee has had its coaching staff coach the All-Star Game. Bucks guard Malik Beasley also made his NBA All-Star Weekend debut, participating in the 3-point contest alongside Lillard.

NOTEABLE GAMES & PERFORMANCES: The Bucks have had some notable team and player performances so far this season. See below for some of Milwaukee's noteworthy games from the 2023-24 season.

- Oct. 26 vs. PHI:
 - In the 2023-24 season opener, Damian Lillard scores 39 points, including 14 in the fourth quarter, to give the Bucks a season-opening 118-117 win over the 76ers. Lillard's 39 points were the most ever by a player making his Bucks debut and the fourth-most in NBA history by a player in his debut with a team.
- Nov. 3 vs. NYK:
 - In the franchise's first In-Season Tournament game, Brook Lopez blocked a career-high-tying 9 shots, helping the Bucks win their first In-Season Tournament game.
- Nov. 9 at IND:
 - Giannis Antetokounmpo scores 54 points, marking the most points scored by a Buck in a road game in franchise history.

 - The Bucks come back from 26 points down in the second half to defeat the Trail Blazers, 108-102. Milwaukee trailed 81-55 with 9:09 left in the third quarter before outscoring Portland 53-21 the rest of the way to pick up its largest comeback-from-behind win in 11 years.
- Dec. 6 vs. NYK:
 - The Bucks pour in a season-high 146 points to defeat the Knicks, 146-122, in the Quarterfinals of the In-Season Tournament at Fiserv Forum to advance to the Semifinals of the IST in Las Vegas.
- Dec. 13 vs. IND:
 - Giannis Antetokounmpo scores a franchise record and career-high 64 points, going 20-for-28 from the field (.714) and 24-for-32 from the free-throw line. By doing so, he became only the fifth player in NBA history to score 60+ points on 70% shooting.
- Jan. 14 vs. SAC:
 - Damian Lillard hits a game-winning three at the buzzer to give the Bucks a 143-142 overtime win over the Kings. With the Bucks down two, Lillard received the inbounds pass, ran the length of the court and hoisted a 32-foot jumper that was nothing but net and sent Fiserv Forum into a frenzy.
- Feb. 3 at DAL
 - Down 25 points at one point, the Bucks come back to beat the Mavericks in Dallas, 129-117. Coupled with their 26-point comeback against the Trail Blazers on Nov. 26, the Bucks now own the two largest comeback wins in the NBA this season. Two high-scoring efficient nights from Antetokounmpo, who had 48 points on 71.4% shooting (20-28 FG) and Lillard, who had 30 points on 90.9% shooting (10-11 FG, 5-5 3FG), powered Milwaukee to the victory.

HEAD COACH DOC RIVERS

Doc Rivers, an NBA Champion head coach and one of the greatest coaches of all-time, takes over as the 18th head coach in franchise history, bringing 24 seasons of head coaching experience to the Bucks. Hired by the team on Jan. 26, Rivers steps in with 36 games remaining in the regular season and with Milwaukee once again near the top of the Eastern Conference standings and its sights set on another deep playoff run.

As head coach of the Orlando Magic (1999-03), Boston Celtics (2004-13), Los Angeles Clippers (2013-20) and Philadelphia 76ers (2020-23), Rivers racked up 1,097 wins, good for ninth-most in NBA history, and owned an overall record of 1,097-763 (.590). He's led his teams to the playoffs in 19 of his 24 seasons as a head coach, with two trips to the NBA Finals and an NBA Championship with the Celtics in 2008. His 111 playoff wins are the fourth-most in league history.

The 1999-00 NBA Coach of the Year, Rivers was named one of the 15 Greatest Coaches in NBA history in 2022 by a panel of 43 current and former NBA head coaches in collaboration with the National Basketball Coaches Association. Overall, his combined 1,208 regular season and playoff wins as a head coach are the eighth-most in NBA history.

Most recently, Rivers served as head coach of the 76ers for three seasons from 2020-23 where he amassed a 154-82 (.653) regular season record and made the postseason all three years. Including his three trips to the playoffs with the 76ers, Rivers has advanced to the playoffs in 15 of his last 16 seasons as a head coach going back to 2008.

A native of Chicago and product of Proviso East High School in Maywood, Illinois, Rivers played and graduated from Marquette University, and his number 31 jersey hangs in the rafters of Fiserv Forum. After being selected in the Second Round of the 1983 NBA Draft, Rivers went on to play 13 seasons in the NBA between 1983-96 with the Hawks, Clippers, Knicks and Spurs. He appeared in 864 games in his career, including in 81 playoff games, and was an NBA All-Star in 1988.
