• **CLIPPERS PR X ACCOUNT:** Follow Clippers PR on X (@ClippersPR) for all official team updates. This protected X account for media members only will regularly practice/shootaround times, injury reports, game attendance, starting lineups, active/inactive lists, game updates and various team updates, in addition to team stats, league stats, game notes and coach and player quotes.

• **PLAYOFF BOUND:** On 4/9 at Phoenix, the Clippers secured the third Pacific Division title in franchise history (last: 2013-14 season) with a 105-92 win over the Suns. LAC also clinched a postseason berth for the 11th time in the last 13 seasons. On 4/14 vs. Houston, the Clippers set a new single season franchise record for total points scored.

• **ROAD WARRIORS:** The Clippers are 26-15 (.634) on the road this season, the third-best winning percentage on the road in the NBA. LAC is first in the NBA on the road in 3P% (39.8) and in FT% (82.8) and fifth in steals (8.1) and in plus/minus differential (3.6). The 26 road wins match the most road wins in a single season in franchise history (2014-15).

• **TRIPLE DOUBLES:** On 3/9 vs. Chicago, James Harden recorded his second triple-double of the season with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. Harden became the sixth player in franchise history to record multiple triple-doubles in a single season. On 4/5 vs. Utah, Harden tallied his third triple-double of the season. It's the most triple-doubles by a Clippers' player since Lamar Odom had four during the 2000-01 season. On 4/9 at Phoenix, Russell Westbrook tallied his 199th career triple-double, the most in NBA history. Westbrook had the Clippers' fifth triple-double of the season, which is tied for the most triple-doubles in a single season in franchise history (2000-01). It's also just the second time in franchise history (1993-94), that the Clippers have had three different players secure a triple-double in a single season.

• **MOVING UP THE LEADERBOARD:** On 2/12 vs. Minnesota, with his 739th career three-pointer as a Clipper, Paul George surpassed Eric Piatkowski for sole possession of first place on the Clippers' all-time three-point field goal list. On 3/24 vs. Philadelphia, George surpassed Jamal Crawford for sole possession of 11th place on the NBA's all-time three-point field goal list. On 3/17 vs. Atlanta, James Harden surpassed Vince Carter for sole possession of 20th place on the NBA's all-time points list. On 3/31 at Charlotte, Harden surpassed Rajon Rondo for sole possession of 14th place on the NBA's all-time assists list. On 4/9 at Phoenix, Russell Westbrook surpassed Jerry West for sole possession of 24th place on the NBA's all-time points list.

• **CONTINUING TO BUILD:** LA at 636-394 (.617) have the NBA's second-best regular season record since the start of the 2011-12 season. On 3/14 at Chicago, the Clippers extended a franchise record of securing a record above .500 to 13 consecutive seasons which is the longest active streak in the NBA and the seventh-longest streak in NBA history. On 4/7 vs. Cleveland, the Clippers reached the 50-win mark for the sixth time in franchise history (last: 51 wins in 2016-17).

• **COMEBACK:** On 4/7 vs. Cleveland, the Clippers overcame a 26-point deficit to win the game 120-118. It was the third-largest comeback in the regular season in franchise history. Since 2018-19, the Clippers have 14 wins when trailing by at least 20 points which is the most by any NBA team during that span.

• **SIX MAN:** Norman Powell has been on a tear off the bench this season, averaging 13.8 points while shooting 48.8% from the field and 42.8% from three. Powell ranks first in the NBA in games with at least 10 points off the bench (59), and is the only player in the NBA to be shooting at least 48% from the field, 42% from three and 82% from the free-throw line off the bench (min. 40 GP). On 4/5 vs. Utah, Powell set the franchise record for most threes made off the bench in a single season.

• **ELITE COMPANY:** On 4/4 vs. Denver, James Harden eclipsed 6,000 career rebounds. Harden joined Russell Westbrook, Oscar Robertson and LeBron James as the only players in NBA history to have at least 25,000 points, 7,000 assists and 6,000 rebounds.

• **GRAMMY TRIP:** The Clippers finished their 2023-24 Grammy Trip with a 6-1 (.857) record. It's the most wins and the best record they've had on this yearly trip since it began in 1999. During the span of the road trip, the Clippers ranked second in the NBA in offensive rating (124.2), third in plus/minus differential (9.9) and fourth in net rating (9.6) and in points (123.3).

• **PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Kawhi Leonard was named Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from Monday, January 29, through Sunday, February 4. This is Leonard's ninth Player of the Week Award, and his third time winning with the Clippers. During the week, Leonard led the Clippers to a 3-1 record, behind averages of 29.8 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals, while shooting 56.6% from the field, 48.0% from the three-point range and 100% from the free-throw line. It's the first time in Leonard's career he has averaged at least 29.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while shooting 100% from the free-throw line over a four-game span.

• **MR. 25,000 x 2:** On 12/14 vs. Golden State, James Harden eclipsed 25,000 career points. Harden became the 24th player in NBA history to achieve the milestone. The 2017-18 MVP finished with a stat line of 28 points, 15 assists, seven rebounds and four blocked shots. Harden joined LeBron James (2/18/10 vs. Denver) as the only players in NBA history to achieve that stat line or better in a single game. On 2/2 at Detroit, Russell Westbrook also eclipsed 25,000 points, becoming the 25th player in NBA history to achieve the feat. Westbrook joined LeBron James as the only players in NBA history to have at least 25,000 points, 9,000 assists and 8,000 rebounds. Westbrook and Harden are the first teammates in NBA history to reach the 25,000 point milestone in the same season.

• **ALL-STARS:** Kawhi Leonard and Paul George were selected as reserves for the 2024 NBA All-Star Game in Indianapolis. Leonard will make his sixth career All-Star appearance (2021, 2020, 2019, 2017, 2016) and his third selection with the Clippers. George will make his ninth career All-Star appearance (2023, 2021, 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016, 2014, 2013), also his third selection with the Clippers. Leonard and George are among six players in franchise history to make at least three All-Star appearances as Clippers. This is the eighth time in franchise history that the team has had multiple All-Stars in a single season.

• **BACK TO BACK:** Tyrone Lue was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for January 2024. This is Lue's second consecutive Coach of the Month award, making him the first coach in franchise history to win the award in consecutive months. For the month of January, the Clippers had the best record in the Western Conference, while ranking first in the NBA in offensive rating (124.6), 3P% (42.3) and FT% (82.8), second in FG% (51.1) and third in plus/minus differential (10.3).

• **COACH OF THE MONTH:** Tyrone Lue was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for December 2023. This is Lue's second Coach of the Month award and first with the Clippers. For the month of December, the Clippers had the best record and offensive rating (122.6) in the Western Conference, while ranking tied for sixth in the NBA in points (121.6).

• **MONTH OF DECEMBER:** The Clippers finished the month of December with a 11-2 (.846) record and were on a nine-game win streak from December 2-20, the longest for the Clippers since the 2015-16 season. During their nine-game win streak, the Clippers ranked second in net rating (9.4), in plus/minus differential (12.4) and in offensive rating (126.6), and tied for sixth in turnovers (12.2).

• **LOS ANGELES TIES:** The Clippers now have four All-Stars from the Los Angeles Area. James Harden, Lakewood (Artesia High School), Kawhi Leonard, Riverside (Martin Luther King High School), Paul George, Palmdale (Knight High School) and Russell Westbrook, Lawndale (Luzinger High School and UCLA).

• **KAWHI:** Kawhi Leonard is the fifth-winningest player in NBA regular-season history with a 506-190 (.727) record.

The Clippers wrapped up the 2023-24 regular season with a 116-105 loss to the Houston Rockets at Crypto.com Arena. LAC once again rested a majority of their key players. Overall, there were eight lead changes with the Clippers leading by as many as five and the Rockets leading by as many as 14. LAC struggled shooting the ball as they were 41-for-104 (39.4%) from the floor and 8-for-37 (21.6%) from beyond the arc. Terance Mann led the team in scoring with 24 points on 10-of-14 shooting with six rebounds and two assists. Amir Coffey tied a season-high with 18 points, three rebounds and two assists. Daniel Theis contributed 16 points, 11 rebounds, two steals and two blocked shots off the bench. Brandon Boston Jr. had 15 points off the bench with six rebounds, four steals and three assists. Xavier Moon contributed 14 points and Kobe Brown had a career-high 9 points. The Rockets were led by Cam Whitmore who had 21 points, six rebounds and five assists. The Clippers will now turn their attention to the postseason as they are set to take on the Dallas Mavericks, with Game 1 scheduled for Sunday in Los Angeles.

The Clippers clinched the third Pacific Division title in franchise history with a 105-92 win over the Phoenix Suns at Footprint Center. LAC improved to 7-1 in their last eight games and secured a franchise-tying 26th road win of the season. The Clippers started the game in dominating fashion as they opened the first quarter 37-10. It was the least amount of points allowed in a first quarter by the Clippers since 2004. LAC closed the half leading 66-33 and never trailed in this contest. However, the Clippers were outscored, 59-39 in the second half to make it a closer game. LAC outrebounded Phoenix, 63-38 and outscored them in points in the paint, 50-36. Overall, the Clippers were 41-for-87 (47.1%) from the floor and 12-for-26 (46.2%) from beyond the arc. Russell Westbrook tallied his 199th career triple-double, the most in NBA history. Westbrook posted a line of 16 points, 15 rebounds, 15 assists and two steals, as he became the only player in franchise history with at least 15 points, 15 rebounds and 15 assists in a single game. Paul George led the team with 23 points, seven rebounds and five assists. Ivica Zubac tallied his sixth-straight double-double, finishing with 17 points, 13 rebounds, two assists and two blocked shots. Terance Mann also tallied 17 points on 8-of-10 shooting with 10 rebounds. Amir Coffey (13) and Norman Powell (10) were the other Clippers in double figures in this contest. The Suns were led by Kevin Durant who had 21 points. The Clippers get another shot at the Suns tomorrow night at Crypto.com Arena.
