- The 76ers defeated the Heat, 98-91, on Monday, improving to 38-30 on the season.
- Philadelphia improves to 14-0 this season when holding the opposition to fewer than 100 points. The 76ers are one of four teams this season to remain undefeated in such games.
- The 76ers blocked 12 shots, tied for the team's second-most blocks in a game this season (12 at MIN 11/22/23). This was the fourth time this season that Philadelphia tallied at least 10 rejections (3-1).
- Philadelphia forced 15 turnovers, their 30th game (20-10 record) of 2023-24 in which their opponent committed at least 15 turnovers (4th in NBA).
- **TYRESE MAXEY** produced a game-high 30 points to go with eight rebounds, and 10 assists, marking his seventh double-double this season (PHI 7-0 in such games). This is the first 30-5-10 game of Maxey's career, making him the eighth guard in team history with such numbers.
- This performance also represented his 48th 20-point game this season. That is tied with Phoenix's **DEVIN BOOKER** for ninth-most such games in the NBA this season.
- Maxey scored 17 of his game-high 30 points in the first quarter, representing his 18th quarter of at least 15 points this season (T-2nd in NBA).
- Maxey connected on a trio of three-pointers, marking his 37th game this season with at least three makes from deep (T-9th in NBA). That represents the fourth-most by a 76er in a single season.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** finished with 22 points and 10 rebounds to go with a career-high five blocked shots. He joins **JOEL EMBIID** (twice) as the only 76ers with a stat line of at least 20 points, 10 rebounds, and five blocks in a single game this season.
- Oubre Jr. is averaging 20.7 points and 6.2 rebounds in nine games this month. He has scored in double figures in eight of his nine contests in March, including six 20-point games.



- **KYLE LOWRY** scored 16 points in his ninth start with Philadelphia and has now reached double figure scoring in four of these nine games. As a starter with the 76ers, Lowry is averaging 9.6 points, 5.1 assists, and 1.2 steals per game.

- The 76ers notched their 37th win of the season on Saturday with a 109-98 win over the Hornets. This represents the team's sixth straight win over Charlotte, improving to 23-2 in its last 25 outings against the Hornets.
- The 76ers held the Hornets to 98 points, improving to 13-0 this season when holding their opponent to fewer than 100 points.
- Philadelphia shot 24-of-25 (96.0%) from the foul line, marking its third game this season with at least 20 makes from the line on at least 95-percent shooting (T-1st in NBA).
- **TYRESE MAXEY** led all players with 30 points, marking his second straight 30-point outing (30 pts, 3/14 at MIL). It is Maxey's 19th 30-point game this season, after entering the 2023-24 campaign with 14 such games through his first 192 contests.
- Since returning to the lineup on March 12, Maxey is averaging a team-high 25.7 points on 45.8-percent shooting from three (11-24 3FG) and 4.0 assists in three games played. He is one of five NBA players with such numbers during that stretch.
- Maxey's first three-pointer on Saturday marked the 500th of his NBA career. By doing so in his 254th NBA game, he is the second fastest 76er to reach that mark. Only **KYLE KORVER** (500 threes in 241 games) did so in fewer games with Philadelphia.
- Maxey is the sixth player with at least 500 threes as a 76er, joining Hall of Famer **ALLEN IVERSON** (885) along with teammate **ROBERT COVINGTON** (724), Kyle Korver (661), **ANDRE IGUODALA** (556), and teammate **TOBIAS HARRIS** (556).
- Maxey extended his three-point streak to 36 games (fifth-longest active streak), marking the franchise's longest such streak since **JJ REDICK** did so in 38 consecutive games from Nov. 23, 2018 to Feb. 28, 2019.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** added in 22 points for his 14th 20-point game this season. Seventeen of his points came in the first half, marking his 10th half with at least 15 points this season.
- **BUDDY HIELD** scored 14 points, including two made threes, marking his 52nd game this season with multiple made threes (seventh-most in the NBA).
- Since joining Feb. 9, Hield has 53 triples, which is tied for 10th in the league during that stretch.
- **CAM PAYNE** scored 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting, marking the sixth time Payne has scored in double figures in his 12 appearances off the bench since joining Philadelphia on Feb. 9. In these 12 games, Payne is averaging 9.2 points.
- Through eight appearances off the bench in March, **PAUL REED** has tallied 87 points and 58 rebounds, making him one of two reserves in the month with at least 85 points and 55 boards.

- The 76ers ended their latest road trip with their third and final meeting of the regular season against the Milwaukee Bucks.
- **TYRESE MAXEY** ended the night with 30 points (12-23 FG, 5-9 3FG), marking his 18th game of 30-or-more points this season through 57 games. Entering this season, Maxey had 14 combined 30-point games across his first three NBA seasons.
 - His 18 games in 2023-24 represent the most 30-point performances in one season by a 76er guard since Hall of Famer **ALLEN IVERSON** (49) during the 2005-06 season.
- Eleven of Maxey's 30-point games this season have come on 50-percent-or-better shooting. These stand as the second-most by a 76er aged 23 or younger in a single season.
- Fifteen of Maxey's points came via three-pointers, giving him 12 games with five-or-more makes from deep (11th in the NBA). He also ranks within the top-11 with 156 made three-pointers from above the break.
- **CAMERON PAYNE** recorded 13 points (5-6 FG, 3-3 3FG), his fourth double-figure scoring game in his seven appearances this month. Across these games, he has totaled 76 points and 24 assists in just over 151 minutes, only **DEVIN BOOKER**, **JALEN BRUNSON** and, **T.J. MCCONNELL** have tallied such numbers so far this month in fewer minutes played.
- **BUDDY HIELD** scored nine points off the bench on 3-of-4 shooting from three-point range. In his career, Hield has 98 games as a reserve with at least three made triples (ninth among active NBA players).

76ers **KELLY OUBRE JR.** played on the Phoenix Suns for part of the (2018-2019) season and all of the (2019-2020) season... Suns Head Coach **FRANK VOGEL** was an assistant coach with the 76ers for the (2004-2005) season... Phoenix's **UDOKA AZUBIKE** (2016-20) and 76ers **JOEL EMBIID** (2013-14) both attended the University of Kansas... Philadelphia's **ROBERT COVINGTON**, along with Phoenix's **JUSUF NURKIC**, and **NASSIR LITTLE** were all teammates together on the Portland Trail Blazers for the (2020-2021) season and part of the (2021-2022) season... Covington was also a teammate of Phoenix's **JOSH OKOGIE** on the Minnesota Timberwolves for part of the (2018-2019) season and part of the (2019-2020) season... The 76ers' **KJ MARTIN** and Suns' **ERIC GORDON** were teammates together on the Houston Rockets from 2020-2023... **SABEN LEE** during part of the 2022-23 season was a two-way signee with the 76ers... Both the 76ers' **TYRESE MAXEY** (2019-20) and Suns' **DEVIN BOOKER** (2014-15) played at the University of Kentucky for their collegiate careers, Suns Head Coach Frank Vogel also attended Kentucky... Philadelphia's **DE'ANTHONY MELTON** and Phoenix's **CHIMEZIE METU** were teammates for the 2016-17 season with the USC Trojans... The Suns' **DAMION LEE** played part of his college career at Philadelphia's Drexel University... 76ers **CAMERON PAYNE** played for the Suns from 2019-2023, averaging 10.1 points during his tenure... Phoenix's **THADDEUS YOUNG** was drafted by Philadelphia in the first round of the 2007 NBA Draft and played with the team from 2007-2014, making the All-Rookie second team in the 2007-2008 season. Young would start in 294 games with the 76ers and ranks 9th in franchise history with 708 steals... 76ers' **MO BAMBA**, **KAI JONES**, and Suns' **KEVIN DURANT** both played collegiately at the University of Texas... Suns' **DAVID RODDY** was part of a draft day trade in 2022 between the 76ers and Memphis Grizzlies that sent him to the Grizzlies for De'Anthony Melton.

THE JO SHOW

- Joel Embiid was named a starter for the 2024 NBA All-Star Game on Jan. 25, marking the seventh career All-Star nod for Embiid. The only 76ers ever with more All-Star selections are Hall of Famers **DOLPH SCHAYES** (12), **JULIUS ERVING** (11), **HAL GREER** (10) and **ALLEN IVERSON** (eight).
- Embiid, Milwaukee's **GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO**, and the Lakers' **LEBRON JAMES** are the only NBA players to be named All-Stars in each of the last seven seasons.
- On Jan. 22 the reigning NBA MVP set a 76ers franchise record, and a 2023-24 NBA high, with 70 points against the San Antonio Spurs. In the process, Embiid recorded the NBA's first-ever stat line of at least 70 points, 15 rebounds, and five assists.
- His record-setting performance made the Cameroon-native one of 10 NBA players in league history to record a 70-point game.
- Embiid did all of this in just 37 minutes played, the fewest ever in a 70-point game. He and Damian Lillard (39 minutes) are the only players in NBA history to score at least 70 points in a game while playing fewer than 40 minutes.
- Through 34 appearances this season, Embiid is averaging career highs in points (35.3), field goals made (11.8), free throws made (10.5), free throw percentage (88.3%), assists per game (5.7) and steals (1.1)
- Embiid's is averaging 35.3 points in 2023-24. Embiid, who captured the scoring title in each of the last two seasons (2021-23), is averaging the highest points per game by a player since **JAMES HARDEN** averaged 36.1 points during the 2018-19 season.
- By also shooting 53.3-percent from the floor, Embiid is on track to be the third NBA player to average at least 35 points on 50-percent shooting for a full season. He would join Hall of Famers Wilt Chamberlain (1960-64) and Michael Jordan (1987-88).
- While adding 11.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists, Embiid is also on pace to join Wilt Chamberlain in 1963-64 as the only NBA players to average 35 points, 10 rebounds and five assists for a full season.
- Embiid set a franchise-record with 22 straight games of 30-plus points from Nov. 17 to Jan. 22, representing the fifth-longest 30-point streak in league history.
- Embiid has tallied 11,919 career points, good for seventh on the franchise's all-time ledger.

A deep dive into Joel Embiid's Most Valuable Moments from 2022-23:

- Posted a then-career-high 59 points to go along with 11 rebounds, eight assists and a career-high-tying seven blocked shots against Utah on Nov. 13.
- On Feb. 15, became the fastest 76er ever to reach 10,000 career points.
- Set a franchise record with 10 straight 30-point games between March 2-20.
- Recorded an Eastern Conference-best 44 games with at least 30 points, the most by a 76er since Hall of Famer Allen Iverson did so during the 2005-06 season.
- Embiid averaged 10.2 first quarter points on 56.9% shooting making him the lone player in the league with such numbers.
- Tallied 50-plus points on three occasions, joining Chamberlain and Iverson as the only 76ers ever with at least three such games in a season.
- Over the course of the season, Embiid earned three Eastern Conference Player of the Month awards (December, January and March/April), as well as four Eastern Conference Player of the Week nods.
 - He is the first NBA player since 2019-20 and the first 76er ever to capture a trio of monthly honors within a single season.
 - His seven career Player of the Month honors are a 76ers record.
