Quotes from Jim Boylan after the Bucks 73-59 win over Detroit:

(On the win...)

It's nice to put things together as a team and come out with a solid win. The guys worked hard and were a more cohesive group today. One huge factor was our energy. I thought the overall hustle was very good, especially in the second half. We turned it up a notch or two after halftime and forced 12 turnovers that led to 17 points. We also limited our turnovers to just 10 in the game, and I believe only one in the second half. For summer league those are pretty darn good numbers.

The game started to slow down for some of the guys. They were more relaxed out there and playing within themselves and the game plan. The guys are starting to understand the way we want them to play.

(On the play if Joe Alexander...)

Joe is one of those guys who it seems the game is slowing down for. He looked more comfortable today and more aggressive. He didn't let his first game performance get into his head. I just thought he responded very well. He was using his athleticism and quickness not only to make plays for himself but also to set up his teammates. He made some good plays out there for us.

(On the play of Ramon Sessions...)

Ramon did a nice job of coming off a high screen and getting into the lane. When that happens he forces the defense to react, so he has options then. If he's open he can hit the runner or if the defense comes to him he can set-up one of his teammates. I thought he did a better job of that today.
