Monty Williams was named head coach of the Detroit Pistons on June 2, 2023.

The 2021-22 NBA Coach of the Year joined Detroit after serving as head coach of the Phoenix Suns for four years, leading the club to its first NBA Finals berth since 1993, a franchise-record 64 wins during the 2021-22 season and a Western Conference title, two Pacific Division titles and three playoff appearances in four seasons.

Over nine seasons as an NBA head coach with Phoenix and the New Orleans Hornets/Pelicans, Williams holds a .522 regular season winning percentage (367-336) including a .518 playoff winning percentage (29-27). In addition to nine seasons as an NBA head coach, he has totaled seven seasons as an assistant coach, two seasons in a front office role, one season as a coaching intern and nine seasons as a player, giving him 28 years of NBA experience since being drafted in 1994.

Williams took over the Suns in 2019-20, one year after the team had the second-worst record (19-53) in the NBA. In his first two seasons he led the team to consecutive increases of at least 15 wins despite fewer games being played in both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 shortened seasons. By accomplishing this, the Suns became just the fifth team in NBA history to increase its win total by 15-plus games in successive seasons. Over the last 45 years, the Suns became just the third team to improve from a bottom two record to a top two record in two seasons or less.

In his first season as Suns head coach, Williams helped transform the team's culture and oversaw a 15-win improvement from the season before his arrival despite playing nine fewer games, tied for the largest improvement in the NBA in 2019-20. He was named the NBA Head Coach of the Seeding Games after guiding the Suns to an 8-0 record in the NBA Bubble.

Williams led the Suns to another 15+-win improvement in 2020-21 (51-31), as Phoenix captured their first Pacific Division title since 2007. The Suns led the NBA in assists (27.2 per game) with the 10th-best scoring offense. The high-powered offense sent Phoenix to their first NBA Finals appearance since 1993 by defeating the L.A. Lakers (4-2), Denver Nuggets (4-0) and Los Angeles Clippers (4-2) to secure the Western Conference Title. The Suns fell to the Milwaukee Bucks (2-4) in the Finals despite Devin Booker's 28.2 points per game.

Williams guided the Suns to the best Western Conference record in the first half of the 2021-22 season, earning a berth as head coach of Team LeBron in the 2022 NBA All-Star Game in Cleveland. He led the Suns to the NBA's best record and second consecutive Pacific Division title in 2021-22 and set the franchise record for wins (64) and road wins in a season (32).

For his success, Williams was named the recipient of the Red Auerbach Trophy as the 2021-22 NBA Coach of the Year. He joined Cotton Fitzsimmons (1988-89) and Mike D'Antoni (2004-05) as the only Suns coaches to win the award. Recognized by his peers in an honor voted on by all 30 NBA head coaches, Williams won the Michael H. Goldberg NBCA Coach of the Year Award in back-to-back seasons in 2020-21 and 2021-22. During his tenure in Phoenix, Williams earned four Western Conference Coach of the Month Awards to join Alvin Gentry and Mike D'Antoni as the only Suns coaches to win the award at least four times while with Phoenix.

Prior to his time in Phoenix, Williams spent five seasons as head coach of the New Orleans Hornets/Pelicans from 2010-2015, leading the team to two playoff appearances. In his first season, the Hornets won 46 games and he was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for January, 2011 and led New Orleans' return to the playoffs after missing the season prior.

Following the departure of All-NBA guard Chris Paul prior to the 2011-12 season, Williams oversaw the growth and development of one of the league's youngest rosters, increasing the team's win total in three straight seasons culminating in 45 wins in 2014-15. Williams earned his start in coaching as a coaching intern with the San Antonio Spurs for the 2004-05 season when the team won an NBA Championship. Before returning to the bench in 2018-19 as an assistant with Philadelphia, he spent two seasons in the Spurs' front office as vice president of basketball operations from 2016-2018.

Williams also served as one of three assistant coaches for the USA Basketball Men's National Team from 2013-2016. As a member of Mike Krzyzewski's staff, he assisted the USA to perfect overall record of 26-0 and a gold medal at the 2014 FIBA World Cup in Spain and the 2016 Olympics in Brazil.

Drafted 24th overall in the 1994 NBA Draft by the Knicks out of the University of Notre Dame, Williams played nine seasons in the NBA and averaged 6.3 points in 456 games with New York, San Antonio, Denver, Orlando and Philadelphia. Of the seven head coaches he played for throughout his NBA career, six won the NBA Coach of the Year Award at least once at some point in their careers (Pat Riley, Don Nelson, Gregg Popovich, Mike D'Antoni, Doc Rivers, Larry Brown) and four have been enshrined in the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame (Riley, Nelson, Brown, Popovich).

Williams was born in Fredericksburg, Virginia and attended Potomac High School in Oxon Hill, Maryland. Recognized as a revered friend and role model to many in the basketball community and beyond, Williams was also named the recipient of the inaugural Sager Strong Award at the 2017 NBA Awards. The award honors the late, iconic Turner Sports sideline reporter, Craig Sager, and presented annually to an individual who has been a trailblazer while exemplifying courage, faith, compassion and grace.

## TEAM NOTES 2023-24

**CHARITABLE DONATION:** In a win against the Kings on Feb. 7, Detroit shot a perfect 22-of-22 from the free throw line. It was their second time this season going perfect from the stripe, joining a 9-of-9 effort against the Grizzlies on Dec. 12. It was their fifth-most makes from the line without missing a shot in franchise history and the most since they went 24-of-24 against Milwaukee on Jan. 12, 2012. It was the fifth-most free throws made without a miss by any team this season.

The Pistons shot .843 FT% (301-of-357) in March, the highest free throw percentage across 16 games and in a single month in franchise history. They are third in the NBA since March 1 shooting .829 FT% and are sixth in the NBA with a .809 FT% since the All-Star break.

In addition, the Pistons are in the midst of one of the best free throw-shooting seasons in franchise history (see tables to right). They are led by Marcus Sasser (.873 FT%).

**BOARD DOMINANT:** The Pistons held a +78 margin on the boards from March 5-15, tied for their highest across six games in franchise history (see tables to right). Detroit had a streak of four consecutive games with 50+ rebounds from March 7-13, their longest since Nov. 29 - Dec. 9, 1991.

**COMEBACK CITY:** After trailing by 23 points (92-69) with 4:59 left in the third quarter against Portland on Feb. 8, the Pistons stormed back to earn a 128-122 victory in overtime. It was tied as the team's largest comeback win since 1997-98, joining Jan. 8, 2021 against Phoenix. It was three points behind their franchise-record 26-point comeback on Feb. 8, 1974, also against Phoenix. Jalen Duren scored 27 points with a career-high 22 rebounds in the win, Jaden Ivey had 26 points on 7-of-7 3FG and Cade Cunningham scored 23, the first time the trio has each scored 20+ points in the same game.

**RUNITUP:** Detroit scored 148 points against Utah on Jan. 3, 2024. It was their most points of the season and the most in franchise history since their NBA-record 186 against Denver in a triple overtime contest on Dec. 13, 1983. The Pistons have scored at least 140 points 32 times in franchise history and four times since 2000. They scored 141 in an overtime win against Charlotte last season (12/14/22).

**DIME CITY:** The Pistons dished out 30+ assists in five consecutive games from Jan. 10-20, the second-longest streak in franchise history (6, April 4-12, 1985) and tied as the fourth-longest streak in the NBA this season.

SECOND UNIT SCORERS: Led in bench scoring by Simone Fontecchio (16.0 PPG), Detroit's second unit ranks 7th in the NBA with 38.8 points per game and 16th with a .347 3PT% this season.

On Jan. 20 against Milwaukee, the Pistons tied their franchise record with 85 bench points, the most by any bench unit in the NBA this season. The bench scored 60+ points in three of four games from Jan. 15 - 22 and scored 68 against Atlanta on April 4, led by a 50-piece from Malachi Flynn.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Detriot sported the second-youngest roster in the NBA after their moves at the All-Star break. With a primary starting lineup all under 23 years old prior to season-ending injuries to Ausar Thompson and Isaiah Stewart (see chart below), the Pistons are the second-youngest roster in the league, weighted by minutes played. **START 'EM YOUNG:** Prior to injuries, Detroit's starting lineup was comprised of five lottery picks under 23 years old, with an average age of 21.6 years old. When all five of **Cade Cunningham, Jaden Ivey, Ausar Thompson, Isaiah Stewart** and **Jalen Duren** started together for the first time on November 27, 2023, against Washington, it was just the 11th time in franchise history that all five Pistons starters were younger than 22 years, 190 days old. It was the third such unique lineup, joining Cunningham, Thompson, Stewart, Duren and Killian Hayes (eight times, 10/25 to 11/10/23) and Ivey, Hayes, Duren, R.J. Hampton and James Wiseman (twice, 4/7 to 4/9/23).

HITTING THE LOTTERY: The Pistons have had 10 players formerly drafted in the lottery (first round, picks 1-14) suit up for them this season, the most in the NBA (Indiana, Sacramento, Toronto, nine). It is tied as the 22nd-most lottery picks to play for a team in NBA history and it is the eighth instance in the last 10 seasons (since 2013-14). See below the list of lottery picks that have donned a Pistons jersey this season (see table below).

HITTING THE COURT: The 2023-24 Pistons have seen 31 individual players take the court this season, one behind the 2023-24 Memphis Grizzlies for the most in a single season in NBA history. Taj Gibson became the franchise record-setting 28th player to take the court on March 18 in Boston, and Chimezie Metu and Buddy Boeheim entered the game on March 20 against Indiana to tie the then-record 30. Jaylen Nowell tied the previous record by becoming player No. 31 on April 5 in Memphis. The Pistons have had 57 different players appear in a game over the past three seasons.



Cade Cunningham ranks **23rd** in the NBA with **22.7** points and **8th** with **7.5** assists per game.

His current streak of three consecutive 30-point games is tied as the longest of his career.

**30-BURGERS:** Detroit's leading scorer, Cunningham scored 30+ points in five of six games from December 26 to January 5. He averaged 28.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, 8.7 assists, 1.0 steals and 0.8 blocks while shooting .525 FG% in 37.0 minutes per game in that span.

Cunningham reached 30 points four times in 10 games after the All-Star break, averaging 25.4 points, 7.9 assists, 5.1 rebounds and 0.5 steals on .481 FG%, .438 3PT% and .913 FT% in that span. He joined Isiah Thomas (nine times), Dave Bing (four times) and Grant Hill (once) as the only players in franchise history to average at least 25 points, seven assists and five rebounds over any 10-game span, and had the highest 3PT% of the group.

Jalen Duren ranks **5th** in the NBA with 11.6 rebounds per game and **8th** with 3.2 offensive boards

He could become the first player in franchise history to average 14.0 PTS, 12.0 REB and 2.0 AST on .600 FG% or better in a season.

**FOR THE RECORD BOOKS:** Duren scored 22 points and with 21 rebounds and a careerhigh nine offensive boards against Oklahoma City on Jan. 28 for his first career 20-20 game. It was the first 20-20 performance by a Piston since Andre Drummond (Jan. 31, 2020) and the fourth-youngest overall in NBA history (20 years, 71 days old). Adding his six assists, it was the ninth 22-21-6 line in Pistons franchise history and the first since Drummond (Nov. 27, 2017).

He later grabbed a career-high 22 boards with 27 points and three blocks in an OT win vs. POR (2/8) for his second career 20-20 game. He became the youngest player in NBA history (19 years, 82 days) with at least 27 PTS and 22 REB in a game.

His third 20-20 game of the season came on March 13 against Toronto, with 24 points, a career-high 23 rebounds (T-career-high nine offensive) and five assists on 8-of-9 from the floor. He became the fourth player in NBA history with at least 20 PTS, 20 REB and 5 AST on at least .880 FG%, joining Wilt Chamberlain, Domantas Sabonis and Willis Reed. He leads the NBA with three 20-20 games this season, the fifth-most in the league in the past five seasons (see table to right):

**HISTORICALLY PERFECT:** On Jan. 15 in Washington, Duren scored 20 points and tied his then career-high of 19 rebounds (set career-high 17 defensive boards) on a perfect 8-of-8 from the floor. It was the first time in franchise history that a player had a 20-19 game on 100% shooting and was just the 11th instance in NBA history, joining Clint Capela (once), Dikembe Mutombo (once) and Wilt Chamberlain (eight times). It was his sixth career 20-point double-double and 10th game with 15+ rebounds.

WALKING DOUBLE-DOUBLE: A near automatic double-double, Duren leads the team and ranks T-8th in the NBA with 42 double-doubles this season (see table to right):

**YOUNG AND HUNGRY:** Duren grabbed his 1,000th career rebound in a double-double against Sacramento on Feb. 7, becoming the sixth-fastest player (102 games) to reach 1K career boards in franchise history. At 20 years, 81 days old, Duren became the second-youngest player to reach 1000 career boards in NBA history (Howard, 19 years, 356 days).

He also became the 9th player in NBA history to record at least 1000 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 blocks before their 21st birthday and was the second-youngest (20 years, 114 days) to reach the benchmarks behind LeBron James (20 years, 110 days).

Duren joins Karl-Anthony Towns and Victor Wembanyama as the only players in NBA history to average at least 10 PTS, 10 REB and 2 AST in their age 20-or-younger season. He is the only 20-year-old in NBA history to average at least 11-11-2.





MAKING THE MOST OF THE OPPORTUNITY: Evbuomwan (pronounced Eh-WOAH-Muh) scored a then-career-high 11 points against the Celtics on March 18 in Boston on 4-of-5 from the floor and 2-of-2 from deep. He matched that effort with 11 points in his first career NBA start against the Pacers on March 20, and scored a career-high 14 points against Boston at home on March 22. The former lvey League Player of the Year averaged 10.8 points and 5.3 rebounds on .517 FG%. over four games from March 18-24 and has averaged 7.0 points and 3.5 rebounds on .571 FG% as a Piston.

CALLED UP: Evbuomwan signed a 10-day contract with the Pistons on February 12, 2024 after spending time with their G League affiliate, the Motor City Cruise. He averaged 15.6 points, 6.9 rebounds and 3.0 assists on .394 3PT% in 35.4 minutes across 13 games for the Cruise this season. He then signed a 10-day contract with the Memphis Grizzlies on Jan. 30, 2024, where he averaged 2.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists in his first career NBA action. He turned in his most productive game on Feb. 4 at Boston, where he grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds (seven offensive) with three points and three assists in 29 minutes of action.

**NEW FACES:** Flynn was acquired from New York on February 8, 2024, along with Quentin Grimes, Ryan Arcidiacono, Evan Fournier and draft and cash considerations. It was his second time being traded this season after being sent to the Knicks from Toronto in the OG Anunoby trade on Dec. 30.

50-PIECEI: Flynn etched his name into history books with a career-high 50 points against Atlanta on April 3, the eighth 50-point game in franchise history and the third off the bench in NBA history. He shot 18-of-25 from the floor, 5-of-9 from three and 9-of-12 from the line and added six rebounds, five assists and three steals to join Blake Giffin (Oct. 23, 2018) as the only players to post 50-5-5 in a game in franchise history. It was the fewest field goals attempted in a 50-point game in franchise history as well. He joined Jamal Crawford (April 9, 2019, 51 points) and Nick Anderson (April 23, 1993, 50 points) as the only 50-pieces off the bench in NBA history and passed Richard Hamilton's 38-point game from Feb. 7, 2009 as the most bench points in franchise history. Flynn's spectacular effort was uncharactaristic in the best way; his 5.2 career points entering the game was the lowest career scoring average by any player to score 50+ points in NBA history. The performance was one of the best in the NBA this season; he joined Luka Doncic and Jalen Brunson as the only players with 50-5-5 and at least three steals.

Fitting RIGHT IN: After being acquired from the Utah Jazz on Feb. 7 for Kevin Knox, the rights to Gabriele Procida and a 2024 second-round pick, Fontecchio came out firing in his first game as a Piston, scoring 20 points with a T-career-high nine rebounds, one assist and one steal against the L.A. Clippers (2/10). It was the eighth-most points by a player in their Pistons debut in the past 25 seasons (since 1998-99), and joined Blake Griffin (Feb. 1, 2018) as the only player to add at least nine rebounds as well. Fontecchio attempted 19 field goals in 32 minutes played, including 10 shots in his first 10 minutes, tied with Marcus Morris (Oct. 27, 2015) as the most attempted field goals in a Pistons debut since Rip Hamilton (Oct. 30, 2002). Fontecchio has scored 247 points as a Piston, his most points over any career 16-game span.

**CAREER NIGHT:** On March 9 against Dallas, Fontecchio posted a career-high 27 points with four rebounds, two assists and one steal in 32 minutes off the bench. It was his most points in any professional competition since scoring 30 for Team Italy agaisnt Serbia in the 2023 FIBA World Cup on Sept. 1, 2023.

IT'S IN HIS BLOOD: Fontecchio's mother, Malì Pomilio, played basketball for the Italian National Team from 1983-89 and won two European titles for AS Vicenza...His grandfather, Vittorio Pomilio, played for the Italian National Team from 1957-60...Fontecchio's father, Daniele, was a professional Italian hurdler who won silver in the 60 meter hurdles at the 1986 European Indoor Championships and in the 110 meter hurdles at the 1985 European Cup, along with 10 national championships at the Italian individual senior level.

INTERNATIONALLY KNOWN: One of four active NBA players born in Italy (Danilo Gallinari, Nico Mannion, Reggie Jackson) and just one of 11 Italian-born players in NBA history, Fontecchio is an active member of the Italian National Basketball team. In the 2023 FIBA World Cup, he led the team with 18.0 points and 28.9 minutes across seven games to go with 5.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists en route to a quarterfinals appearance. He led the Italians in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics as well with 19.3 points and 30.3 minutes with 3.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals across four games in another quarterfinals appearance.

**OLYMPIC MEDALIST:** Fournier starred on the French National Team in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, where he led the team with 18.7 points per game with 3.2 rebounds and 2.5 assists on .378 3PT% in 28.3 minutes across six games. The French went 5-1 overall in the tournament and fell to the United States, 87-82, in a tightly contested gold medal game. He led the team again in scoring at the 2023 FIBA World Cup with 13.8 points per game as the French came in 18th. In total, Fournier has seven international basketball medals: he won bronze in the FIBA World Cup in both 2019 and 2014, earned silver at the 2022 FIBA EuroBasket and bronze in the same event in 2015, bronze on the French U-20 Team at the 2011 European Championship and silver in the 2009 European U-18 Championship. He ranks 15th in French National Team history with 1,239 points.

In his international career, Fournier played in 59 games with Union Poitiers Basket 86 of the French League...In 2011-12, averaged 14.0 ppg., 3.2 rpg., 2.2 apg. and 1.50 stlpg. in 26.0 minpg....At 19 years old, became the youngest player in French League history to score at least 20 points in a game with 21 on Feb. 5, 2011 against SLUC Nancy...Earned the French League Rising Star Award as the league's most improved player in both 2011 and 2012...Participated in the Nike Hoop Summit in 2011.

The No. 26 overall pick in the 2009 NBA Draft, Gibson holds career averages of 8.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.0 blocks in 23.5 minutes per game. Gibson appeared in 71 career playoff games and averaged 7.8 points, 4.9 rebounds and 0.6 assists in 22.3 minutes. NEW FACES: Grimes was acquired from New York on Feb. 8, 2024, along with Evan Fournier, Ryan Arcidiacono, Malachi Flynn and draft and cash considerations.

**COLLEGIATE CHAMPS:** As collegiate teammates for two seasons at the University of Houston (2019-21), Grimes and **Marcus Sasser** powered the Cougars to the Final Four in 2021, where they fell to eventual National Champion Baylor. The duo led the 28-4 AAC Champions in scoring, as Grimes led the team with 17.8 points and Sasser was second with 13.7 points. Grimes, the 2021 American Athletic Conference Player of the Year and AAC Tournament MVP, averaged 17.0 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals across five NCAA Tournament games after scoring 21 points on 5-of-9 3FG in the 2021 AAC Championship game against Cincinnati. He was ranked as the No. 8 overall recruit in the 2018 RSCI Top 100.

**HAVE A NIGHT:** Ivey scored 32 points on Jan. 17 against Minnesota with four rebounds, six assists and one steal on 4-of-6 3FG. It capped a run of six games where he averaged 21.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 6.2 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks, joining Cade Cunningham (once) and Grant Hill (three times) as the only first-or-second year players in franchise history to average at least 21-5-5-1-1 over any six game stretch.

He recorded the best offensive night of his career on Feb. 7 in Sacramento, where he scored a career-high 37 points with five 3-pointers to go with six rebounds and seven assists. It was his fifth career 30-point game and second of the season.

**SCORING MACHINE:** In eight games from Dec. 21 to Jan. 5, Ivey averaged 16.5 points with 5.0 rebounds and 4.3 assists on .485 (16-of-33) 3PT%. It was the highest 3-point shooting percentage over any eight-game span in his career. The stretch included back-to-back games with 20 points from Dec. 21-23. He later shot .484 3PT% (15-of-31) over seven games from Jan. 17-31.

He showed off his smooth stroke on Feb. 8 against Portland, where he made a career-high seven 3-pointers on a perfect 7-of-7 from behind the line. It was tied for the 16th-most 3-pointers in a game in franchise history and the second-most without a miss, trailing only Ben Gordon's 9-of-9 night from 3-point territory on March 21, 2012 against Denver.

**ALL-TIME PRODUCTION:** After scoring 10+ points in 69 of 74 games last season and ending the year on a rookie franchise-record 39 game double-digit scoring streak, Ivey has continued to be a near-automatic 10+ points on the court while contributing across the board as well. 




**3 & D:** At the time of his injury, Stewart was shooting a career-best .383 from deep, which ranked **25th** among Power Forwards and Centers in 3PT% this season. He was also one of the best defenders in the NBA, ranking **5th** in the league with a .430 defended field goal percentage (min. 10 field goals defended per game). He ranked third on the Pistons with a 114.5 defensive rating and five double-doubles.

**SCORING STREAK:** Stewart scored at least 10 points in 11 consecutive games from Jan. 12 to March 5, the longest streak of his career. He has scored 10+ in six straight games two other times: Oct. 25 - Nov. 2, 2023 and Feb. 8-24, 2022. He averaged 13.3 points per in this span, the highest 11-game scoring average in his career.

**TOP PERFORMANCE:** Stewart dropped his first 20-point game of the season on December 23 against Brooklyn with five rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block on 8-9 FG (4-5 3FG). It was the sixth 20-point game of his career and his first time recording 20-5-5 in a game. It was also his third career instance making at least four 3-pointers in a game, and his first time shooting 4-of-5 (.800 3PT%) or better with as many attempts.

S.W.A.T. TEAM: On January 22 against Milwaukee, Stewart scored 19 points with eight rebounds, two assists, T-season-high two steals and a career-high five blocks. It surpassed his previous career-high of four (four times) and tied Jalen Duren and Ausar Thompson for the most rejections by a Piston this season.





**SWIPER:** Thompson recorded a steal in 12 consecutive games from Jan. 24 to Feb. 22 (1.6 steals per game), the longest streak by a rookie this season the third-longest by a rookie in franchise history. He collected a career-high five steals against Cleveland on March 1, the most by a Piston this season and the sixth-most by a rookie in franchise history.

**ATTACK THE GLASS:** An undersized force crashing the boards, Thompson ranks 6th among rookies in franchise history with 129 offensive rebounds, which ranked third in the NBA among players 6'7" or shorter (Saddiq Bey, Scottie Barnes) at the time of his injury.

**ROOKIE RANKINGS:** Among Pistons rookies in the past 50 seasons through their first 63 career games, Thompson ranked **6th** in total rebounds (402), **6th** in offensive rebounds (129), **8th** in blocks (59) and **6th** in steals (68). See below where he ranks among this year's rookie class:

**STARTING OFF STRONG:** Thompson dominated defensively in his first NBA appearance with five blocks, the most ever by a Piston in their NBA debut (Terry Tyler, 4, 1968) and tied for the third-most by any player in their debut in NBA history. That got him off on the right foot as he averaged 12.2 points, 10.7 rebounds, 3.6 assists, 1.3 steals and 1.5 blocks through his first 14 NBA games with 10+ points seven times (including three straight from Nov. 1-6) and 10+ rebounds eight times, including 73 total boards over a six-game stretch from Nov. 8-19.



**G LEAGUE RECAP:** Averaged 16.7 points, 6.2 rebounds, 1.3 assists, 0.8 steals and 1.0 blocks in 32.9 minutes across 28 games (22 starts) for the Motor City Cruise this season, shooting .389 FG%, .323 3PT% and .795 FT%.

**CAREER GAME:** On November 6 vs. Golden State, Umude erupted for career-highs in points (15), rebounds (3), 3-pointers (4) and minutes played (16). He splashed home 4-of-5 from 3-point land in a 5-of-8 shooting night from the field, including 1-of-1 from the free throw line.

**BREAKOUT PLAYER:** After earning a two-way contract in the preseason, Umude has played in 13 games for the Pistons this year with five 10+ point performances, including three in a row from 11/17-20. He shot .538 (7-13) 3PT% in that span. After returning to the Pistons on February 8 at Portland and going 3-of-4 from behind the line, he shot .548 from deep through his first 16 NBA games of the season.

**SEASON RECAP:** Played in 25 games for the Pistons G League affiliate Motor City Cruise in 2022-23, averaged 15.4 points, 4.8 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 0.7 blocks in 27.5 minutes per game...Led the team with 276 points in the Showcase with 108 rebounds, and 30 assists in 493 minutes...Finished third in scoring among all rookies in Winter Showcase (15.3). Dropped a career high 26 points on a career-best seven 3-pointers against Raptors 905 (1/12).

SEASON HIGH: Wiseman scored a season-high 24 points against Boston on March 22, his most points as a Piston and his second 20-point game of the season (12/15 vs PHI, which was his second career 20-10 game). He followed the outing with back-to-back double-doubles against New Orleans (3/24) and New York (3/25), his second career instance with consecutive double-doubles (March 13-14, 2023 with Detroit). It highlighted a run of strong play where he has averaged 14.6 points, 9.0 rebounds and 1.8 assists over five games from March 18-25, his first time averaging 14 PTS and 9 REB over five games since March of 2023. He turned in another double-double on April 1 against Memphis, which gave him three in five games from March 24-April 1.

STRONG STRETCH: Wiseman recorded his second double-double of the season on March 9 against Dallas with 17 points, 12 rebounds, four assists and one block. He scored 10+ points in three consecutive games on March 7-11, his first double-digit scoring streak time since Dec. 12-18.

He averaged 11.0 points and 10.3 rebounds over his three games from March 9-13, his second time averaging 10/10 over a three-game span as a Piston. The previous instance came within a six-game span from March 9-19, 2023 (16.3 points and 11.3 rebounds).

CHANGE OF SCENERY: After recording three double-doubles through 60 games with Golden State, Wiseman collected five in his first 14 games with Detroit. He ended the season with eight double-doubles as a Piston on 12.7 PPG and 8.1 RPG. He scored 10+ in 18 of 24 games played with 10+ boards nine times. In the process, he turned in his first career 20-10 game with 22 points and 13 rebounds vs. Miami (3/19). Wiseman also set a career rebound mark twice with the Detroit, first with 13 boards and 16 points against Charlotte (3/9), and two-games later a career-best 14 rebounds (five offensive) and 18 points against Indiana (3/13).

SEASON SUMMARY: Appeared in 45 games (22 starts) last season with both Detroit and Golden State, averaging 10.0 points, 5.9 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 19.3 minutes....Played in 24 games (two starts) with the Pistons, averaging 12.7 points, 5.9 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 19.3 minutes...Played in 21 games (no starts) with the Warriors, averaging 6.9 points, 3.5 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 12.5 minutes...Scored 10-plus points 17 times and 20plus points three times with Detroit...Led the team in scoring twice and rebounds eight times...Posted seven double-doubles in a Pistons uniform after notching just three through 60 games as a Warrior...Scored a season-high 30 points (GSW) with six rebounds and two assists at BKN (12/21)... Tallied 22 points and 13 rebounds on 10-13 FG vs. MIA (3/19).
